

Do You Know What

This Sign Means



A parking spot designated with this sign is reserved exclusively for vehicles displaying an original and valid Disabled Person Parking Permit, issued by the Ministry of Transportation (MTO).

Parking is an integral part of travelling for many persons with disabilities. It is a way of opening up access to a community. If parking is not available it can result in the person not being able to work, shop, gain access to their doctor's office or even a hospital.

The front side of this Parking Permit needs to be clearly visible from outside of the vehicle. It should be placed on the dashboard or attached to a turned down sun visor.



Vehicles that do not display such a permit are in violation of the City of London Parking Bylaw. The fine for such an offence is a minimum of \$300.
